I am desirous of acquainting myself with the standards of tuition at South American Universities for the purpose of comparison and contrasting, and I then intend to make a ver precise report for the British Ministry of Education.

I shall therefore be grateful if you could inform me of the prevailing facilities, e.g. awards tenable at your University, and the length of time of these awards, and if you would be good enough to forward the necessary forms to my above mentioned address.

I am primarily interested in Biology and Chemistry, the subjects which together with Physics form the basis for the British first M.B. and Inter Science Examinations at practically every University.

I am actively engaged in the lecturing of the two subjects mentioned. I am to a lesser degree interested in Physiology (a subject required for the second M.B. etc.) but not in Anatomy.

My present knowledge of the Spanish language is moderate, but shall be brought up to standard by the time of arrival.
