We appreciate your giving us your impression of the Catholic University of Chile. Unfortunately, aid to this medical school falls quite outside the present policies of the Rockefeller Foundation. We are gradually withdrawing from aid to medical education as such and laying stress upon the development of research in the fundamental sciences. Our interest in medicine, therefore, is shifting from education to investigation. Under another cover I am sending you a copy of a recent Review which briefly outlines our new program.
